



Hill County Indigent Health Care Program

Hill County will use the following rules and procedures to comply with its responsibilities under the Indigent Health Care and Treatment Act to provide basic medical coverage for eligible residents of Hill County who are not eligible for any other program, and have income less than 21% of the Federal Poverty Level. Eligible residents will be assigned a dedicated primary care physician in Hill County.

Applications can be requested from the Indigent Health Care Office located at the Hill County Court House, Hillsboro, TX, or an application will be mailed upon request by calling (254)582-4065. Assistance in completing the application will be provided, if needed.

Property, bank accounts and other countable resources must be verifiable and within limits established by state rules. Applicants must have a valid Social Security number.

Funded by: General Tax Levy Revenue for Hill County, as mandated by state law.

Services:

- Medically necessary office visits and annual physical exams
- Diagnostic testing and imaging
- Specialist care upon referral of primary physician
- Hospitalization (in-patient to max. of 30 days or \$30,000 per year)
- Out-patient hospital care/emergency room
- Other appropriate health care services that may be determined to be cost-effective

Pharmacy: - 3 prescriptions per month, generic required if available, 30 day supply only.

Exclusions:

- Dental services
- Vision care
- Chiropractic services
- Durable medical supplies
- Transportation services
- Mental Health services
