

TRANSPORT DEPUTY

STARTING PAY: \$18.42/hour; \$38,313/year; after first year: \$18.86/hour; \$39,228/year (base pay)

Job Summary: The Transport Deputy will be required to deliver or retrieve inmates from or to the Hill County Jail and Courthouse, Texas Department of Corrections, various medical/dental facilities, multiple cities, counties, and State facilities.

REQUIREMENTS

- Must be at least 21 years of age; be a citizen of the United States **AND** possess a HS Diploma or equivalent
- Must possess a valid state driver's license and have a good driving record
- Must possess Peace Officer TCOLE license
- Ability to work various shifts, weekends and holidays
- Must have the knowledge necessary to understand basic operational, technical, and office processes;
- Must be able to perform defense tactics against individuals and frequently interact with hostile/combatative people
- Carefully observe incidents, accurately remembering names, faces, numbers, circumstances and places;
- Make independent judgments and adopt quick, effective, and responsible courses of action at any time;
- Prepare clear and comprehensive reports;
- Effectively represent the Sheriff's Office in contacts with the public and other law enforcement agencies;
- Establish and maintain cooperative relationships with those contacted during the course of work;
- Possess and maintain a cooperative and positive attitude;
- Required to occasionally work overtime – may include weekends and evenings;
- Required to be bondable under the Sheriff's Official Bond;
- Required to participate in continuing education courses.

BENEFITS & PERKS:

- Additional monthly stipends paid for certification/education level
- Longevity Pay after completion of three years of service
- PTO (Paid Time Off): Accrued 6.81 hours per pay period
- 13 paid holidays observed per year
- FREE employee medical, dental and life insurance
- Uniforms and equipment, including vest, sidearm, leather gear and a cell phone are provided
- Hill County is a member of Texas County & District Retirement System (TCDRS)
